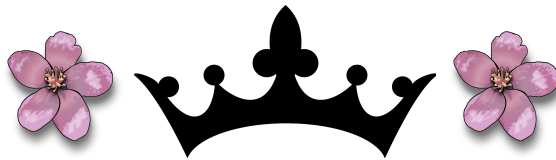

- ❖ Doors will open to contestants at 8:00 am, unless otherwise stated by approved hair and makeup artists (Dressing rooms will be available.)
 - **NO males are permitted to be in dressing rooms.**
- ❖ Doors will open to the public at 9:00 am.
- ❖ \$5.00 entry fee at the door (does not apply to contestants OR one guest who will escort Tiny Miss contestants to the stage).
- ❖ \$55.00 Pageant Registration Fee
- ❖ \$5.00 off for current Legacy Christian Academy students
- ❖ **\$5.00 discount if application is postmarked by January 13, 2025**
- ❖ **Regular registration deadline is February 1, 2025 (if mailing, must be postmarked by February 1st)**

Age Divisions:

- Tiny Miss (2 - 3 years old) *One adult must escort the child to the stage.
- Little Miss (4 - 6 years old)
- Young Miss (7 -9 years old)
- Pre-Teen (10 - 12 years old)
- Jr. Miss (13 - 15 years old)
- Miss (16 - 22 years old)
- Ms. (23 & Up) *Unmarried or married

*Contestants must enter the divisions for their age as of March 1, 2025

Photogenic Award

- You may bring one photo to the pageant with you to compete in the Miss Photogenic competition in each age group. **Photos must be turned in at the pageant by 9:00 am for the morning pageant and 12 noon for the afternoon pageant.** Photos should be no larger than 8x10 and no smaller than 5x7. Photos should not have a frame. You may place photos in a plastic cover. Please have the contestant name and age division on the back of the photo. We are not responsible if a photo is damaged. People’s Choice Award

- Pageant guests will be able to vote on the contestant that they would like to see win this award. Each vote is \$1. There will be a designated table on the day of the pageant. There will be one overall winner from the morning pageant and one overall winner from the afternoon pageant. **CASH ONLY**

Pageant Details

Formal Attire/ Gown	Tiny and Little	Gown/dress of choice. May wear “Sunday Best/Flower Girl” dress or pageant dress (no “heavy glitz”); dress may be short or long and have rhinestones/ruffles. Judging will focus on personality and overall impression.
	Young and Pre-Teen	Gown/dress of choice, should be full-length. Judging will focus on appearance, gown, personality, overall impression.
	Jr Miss	Gown/dress of choice. Judging will focus on appearance, gown, personality, overall impression. Gown may be strapless and/or have a slit (should not come far above knee).
	Miss	Gown/dress of choice. Judging will focus on appearance, gown, personality, overall impression. Gown may be strapless and/or have a slit (should not come far above knee).
	Ms.	Gown/dress of choice. Judging will focus on appearance, gown, personality, overall impression. Gown may be strapless and/or have a slit (should not come far above knee).
Personality Wear	Pre-teen, Jr., Miss, Ms.	NEW this year, contestants will participate in personality wear. Attire should reflect one’s personality, interests, hobbies, etc. Judges will focus on appearance, personality, style, fit, overall impression.

ON-STAGE QUESTION

-Pre-Teen, Jr Miss, Miss, Ms.-

- An unrehearsed on-stage question to identify the impromptu public speaking ability of each contestant. Questions will be general, age-appropriate questions and will be asked after each contestant completes their walk on stage.

SPECIAL INFORMATION

- In the event of a tie during the tabulation of scores, all divisions will be broken using the highest overall impression score.

AWARDS/GIFTS

Across the seven age divisions, multiple awards and gifts will be presented:

- All seven age divisions: Queen title/1st RU/2nd RU and the following side awards: Photogenic (each age division), Community Service (one overall), and People's Choice (one overall - the contestant with the most amount of votes (\$1 per vote).
- Queen awards include:
 - A full-rhinestone crown and embroidered sash
 - Crown Carrier with various gifts
- Runners-up and Photogenic winners will receive trophies
- Community Service Winner will receive a plaque

2025 RULES AND REGULATIONS

Please read the following, as signing the application page acknowledges your agreement to these rules. The 2025 queens are also required to abide by these rules after receiving their title.

1. Contestants must be female who have always been female. Ladies in the Ms. category can be married, divorced, and have children. All other age groups, ladies must be single, never married, without children, and never having been pregnant.
2. Contestants must possess strong moral character, have never been convicted of a crime, have any pending criminal charges, or have committed an act or engaged in an activity which is or could be characterized as dishonest, immoral, indecent, or in bad taste. These regulations also apply to improper images/actions on all social media outlets.
3. If a potential contestant has been suspended or expelled from school for behavioral/action-related matters at any point in time, they are **required** to disclose this information in full transparency to the pageant directors via a formal conversation to determine if they meet the requirements listed in line item #2 (see above). Ability to participate will be at the discretion of the Pageant Committee.
4. All contestants must enter the division corresponding with their age as of pageant day. All winners are required to sit out one (1) year; they will be eligible to compete again in the 2027 pageant if they have reached the minimum age for the next age division (may not win the same title/age division twice).
5. Contestant line-up will be in alphabetical order by last name. Official times will be e-mailed out once headcounts in each division are finalized.
6. The First Runner-Up in each age division must be willing to assume all duties if the winner is unable or unwilling to fulfill her duties.

- In the event a 2025 titleholder is suspended or expelled from school for behavioral/action-related matters during her reign or involved in illegal activity, she will be required to forfeit her title (including crown and sash) immediately.
7. The 2025 titleholders are required to attend/participate/abide in/by the following:
 - Various community service opportunities either individually, or organized through LCA.
 - Other events as requested by the Pageant Committee.
 - All appearances, such as parades, must be made with the crown/sash.
 - Attend the 2026 Miss Legacy Blossom Pageant for the final walk and crowning.
 8. All contestants and family/guests must always conduct themselves in a proper manner throughout pageant day. Any display of uncooperative or unsportsmanlike conduct will result in immediate disqualification of the contestant and removal of the individuals from the property. Incidents will also be directed to the pageant committee with the potential of the individual(s) being banned from the program as a contestant; this applies to incidents before/during/after the pageant, if related to the pageant/titleholders.
 9. All division winners are expected to be present at the end of the afternoon pageant for a group photo.
 10. The Ms. winner is responsible for leading efforts to organize a fundraiser to benefit LCA.

All rules, regulations, awards, schedules, and information pertaining to the pageant are subject to change at the discretion of the Pageant Committee, if necessary.
